## Ensure Clear Learning Objectives & Expectations

Detailed syllabus

Redesigned course curriculum to match e-learning

Pre-planning and session wise clear objectives of each classes

Due dates and schedule

Clear assignments and directions

## Solicit Student Response & Evaluation

Online quizzes without announcement

Mentimeter/ Polls

Encourage student participation through Chat/ discussion forums

Regular student feedback for effective reflection to improve online interaction

## Offer Prompt Feedback to the Students

Timely response to the students

Recognition of the student effort / constructive criticism

Frequent use of blogs, Google classrooms/ LMS to handle student queries

Availability of teacher before & after the class through online means

## Ensure Asynchronous Learning

Enable topic-wise Videos by the teacher to the students

Provide interactive e-lectures through online resources

Availability of study material through Google classroom/ LMS

## Enable Faculty-Moderated Student-Student Interaction

Group discussions/ role plays through Breakout Rooms

Asking students to frame questions & seek response from peers
